One-Time Block Grants

ONE-TIME BLOCK GRANTS

Arts, Music, and Instructional Materials Discretionary - \$5.4 million

- MJUSD impact approximately \$300k reduction
- Disbursement
 - 50% of funds distributed December 2022
 - Remaining disbursement expected late September 2023
- Spending Deadline June 30, 2026
- Allowable Uses:
 - Standards-aligned professional development and instructional materials
 - Diverse book collections and culturally relevant texts in English, pupil's home language, or combination of both
 - Operational Costs
 - o COVID-19 pandemic-related supplies
- Board Approved Plan for Expenditures

One-Time Block Grants

Learning Recovery Emergency Grant - \$13.5 million

- 2023-24 State Enacted Budget reduced this amount to \$6.8 billion
 - MJUSD impact approximately \$2.3 million reduction
- Purpose
 - Assist school districts, county offices of education, and charter schools with long-term recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic
- Allocation
 - Based 2021-22 Second Principal Apportionment ADA multiplied by 2021-22 Unduplicated Pupil Percentage (UPP)
- Spending Deadline June 30, 2028
 - Expenditure reporting due by Dec 15, 2024, and annually thereafter through Dec 29, 2029.
- Allowable Uses
 - Increase or stabilize instruction learning time
 - Pupil Supports to address other barriers to learning
 - Decrease or stabilize staff-to-pupil ratio
 - Instruction for credit-deficit students
 - Additional academic services
 - Close learning gaps

Prop. 28 - Arts & Music

 The 2023-24 Enacted Budget includes a modest revision to the amount to be provided for Proposition 28, the Arts and Music Education Funding

Lottery Allocations

- Unrestricted
 - Site Discretionary Expenditures
 - Increase from \$170 per ADA to \$177
- Restricted
 - Proposition 20
 - Instructional Materials
 - Increase from \$67 per ADA to \$72
