

MJUSD has established the **Financial Advisory Committee** to serve as a collaborative partnership between the district's education partners. The primary role of the FAC is to monitor financial issues and trends facing the Marysville Joint Unified School District and to provide input to the Board and the District's administration regarding financial and related issues. Acting in the public's best interest as a community representative and liaison to the Superintendent and the Cabinet, the FAC shall be fact-finding and advisory in nature, and not executive. The role and actions of the FAC shall be purely advisory in nature and not subject to any discussions that impact collective agreements or compensation. The FAC shall not have the authority to make monetary or other decisions for the district. The Board of Education recognizes that advisory committees enable the Board to better understand the interests and concerns of the community.
